(ECF No. 1.) On December 21, 2015, summonses issued for the defendants in this action. 18 (ECF No. 5.) On March 25, 2016, Plaintiffs filed a first amended complaint. (ECF No. 11.) 19 Pursuant to Rule 4 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure "[i]f a defendant is not served 20 within 90 days after the complaint is filed, the court -- on motion or on its own after notice to the 21 plaintiff -- must dismiss the action without prejudice against that defendant or order that service 22 be made within a specified time." Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m). Plaintiff has not filed a notice that the 23 defendants in this action have been served. 24 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 25 1. Plaintiffs shall serve the summonses and first amended complaint in this action 26 within thirty days from the date of service of this order; and 27
