19 Pending before the Court is the United States' application for a final order garnishing defendant  
20 Joseph M. Cuellar's interests in various financial accounts he and his spouse, Alicia Cuellar, (the  
21 Cuellars) maintain at garnishee Citibank, N.A. (the Application). ECF No. 11. The Court denied  
22 Defendant's motion to stay the United States' efforts to collect restitution on July 20, 2015 (ECF No.  
23 15) and, having reviewed the court files and the Application, and finding good cause therefrom, hereby  
24 GRANTS the Application. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

25 1. Garnishee Citibank shall DELIVER, within twenty (20) days of the filing of this Order, a
