**ORDER WITHDRAWING ORDER  
GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S REQUEST FOR  
ISSUANCE OF SUBPOENA TO OBTAIN  
RECORDS FROM DIGNITY HEALTH,  
MERCY HOSPITAL**

**(Doc. 44)**

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15 Plaintiff is a prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* in this civil rights action  
16 pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. This action is proceeding on Plaintiff's claims in the First  
17 Amended Complaint against Dr. Ngozi Ignibinoza, Dr. Scharffenberg, Dr. Kandkhorova, Dr.  
18 Ugwueze, and Dr. Sunduram for deliberate indifference to Plaintiff's serious medical needs in  
19 violation of the Eighth Amendment. On August 29, 2017, Plaintiff filed a subpoena to obtain  
20 medical records for treatment he received at Dignity Health, Mercy Hospital, 2215 Truxtun Ave.,  
21 Bakersfield, CA, 93301. (Doc. 43.)

22 On October 3, 2017, an order issued indicating that Plaintiff met the requirements for a  
23 subpoena to issue. (Doc. 44.) In the order, defense counsel was directed to file a statement  
24 indicating the steps taken to obtain the records sought by Plaintiff and whether counsel would be  
25 willing to provide Plaintiff copies of any documents obtained. (*Id.*) On October 12, 2017,  
26 defense counsel filed a statement indicating that records from the facility where Plaintiff is  
27 currently housed had been recently received and included records from outside providers. (Doc.  
28 45.) Defense counsel forwarded a copy of the records received to Plaintiff that same week. (*Id.*)

1 It, therefore, appears that a subpoena is no longer required.

2 If after receipt and review of those records, Plaintiff believes they are incomplete, Plaintiff  
3 may file a renewed request for a subpoena. Before any subpoena will issue, the request must  
4 specifically state which records are lacking and their relevance to this action.

5 Based on the foregoing, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** that the order granting Plaintiff's  
6 request to subpoena records from Dignity Health, Mercy Hospital, issued on October 3, 2017,  
7 (Doc. 44) is **WITHDRAWN**.
