Because the application was incomplete, the Court could not 16 evaluate whether Plaintiff was sufficiently impoverished to justify proceeding without paying the 17 filing fee for his lawsuit. Plaintiff was ordered to pay the filing fee or re-file a completed 18 application. Plaintiff has since submitted an amended application which sets forth the showing 19 required by 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). Doc. 4. 20 Accordingly, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. The Clerk 21 of Court is directed to issue the summons and new case documents.
