ORDER EXTENDING PAGE LIMITATION  
FOR MOTION FOR SUMMARY  
JUDGMENT

On April 17, 2017, the parties to this action filed a stipulation seeking to extend the page limitations for briefing for a motion for summary judgment in this action from twenty-five pages to thirty-one pages. (Doc. No. 59 at 1.) The parties represent that the complexity and numerosity of the claims involved in this case warrants an extension of the page limitation.
