(Doc. 32) 20 21 The settlement was contingent upon the completion of an IEE and the IEP reviewing it. <u>Id</u>. Thus, the Court ordered the dismissal documents to be filed by December 2, 2016, when these actions were to be 22 completed. Id. 23 On December 2, 2016, the Court granted in part the stipulation to extend the deadline to 24 dismiss the action to March 24, 2016. (Doc. 44) The stipulation indicated that the assessment to be 25 completed by the specialist was not yet finished and Rosedale had not yet made the payment required 26

In the event counsel determine they cannot complete the settlement by this deadline, no

later than March 17, 2016, they SHALL file a joint request for additional time. The

1	request SHALL set forth a comprehensive description of the impediments to dismissal and an explanation why these impediments could not more quickly be overcome.

3	Doc. 44 at n. 1. Once again, on March 24, 2017, the Court granted the stipulation to extend the
4	deadline to April 28, 2017 to dismiss the action, this time because the Rosedale needed more time to
5	"effectuate payment for the vision therapy independent educational evaluation." (Doc. 48) Despite
6	this, April 28, has come and gone and no dismissal papers have been filed. Therefore, the Court
7	ORDERS:
8	1. No later than May 19, 2017 , the parties SHALL show cause in writing why sanctions,
9	up to and including dismissal of this action, should not be imposed for their failure to comply with the
10	Court's orders.
11	Failure to comply will result in the Court dismissing this action.
12
