Plaintiff's 24 opposition deadline has not passed, but Defendant represents that Plaintiff's counsel 25 has expressed non-opposisiton. 26 Good cause appearing, Defendant's motion to modify the discovery and scheduling 27 order (ECF No. 34) is granted. The deadline for the completion of all discovery, 28
