Petitioner has paid the filing fee. 18 Petitioner is incarcerated in Kern County and was convicted in Los Angeles County. Kern 19 County is in the Fresno Division of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of 20 California, and Los Angeles County is in the United States District Court for the Central District of California. 21 22 Pursuant to 28 U.S.C § 2241(d), courts in both the district of conviction and the district of 23 confinement have concurrent jurisdiction over applications for habeas corpus filed by state 24 prisoners. Because petitioner was not convicted in this district, and is not presently confined 25 here, this court does not have jurisdiction to entertain the application. 26 Petitioner is not seeking to overturn his underlying conviction, but rather complains of 27 conditions of his confinement, in particular his restriction from family visits in light of his status //// 28 1

1	as a convicted sex offender. Therefore, the action will be transferred to the Fresno Division of the
2	Eastern District of California.
3	Accordingly, in the furtherance of justice, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
4	1. This action is transferred to the United States District Court for the Eastern District of
5	California sitting in Fresno; and
6	2. All future filings shall reference the new Fresno case number assigned and shall be
