**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST OF *PRO SE* LITIGANT TO E-FILE**

(Doc. 6)

15 Plaintiff, Daniel P. Klahn, Sr., is a former state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma*  
16 *pauperis* in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983.

17 Plaintiff has requested leave to be permitted to e-file documents in this Court's CM/ECF  
18 case management system. Plaintiff indicates that he has an account he has used in the past in  
19 other cases. However, although Plaintiff may have an account with another court, there is no  
20 record of Plaintiff having an account with this Court. Thus, while his request to be allowed to e-  
21 file is granted, Plaintiff must set up a new account to do so.

22 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 23 1. Plaintiff's motion, filed on November 17, 2016, is GRANTED;
- 24 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to mail the "Petition by Pro Se Litigant for ECF
- 25 Registration and Consent to Electronic Service" to Plaintiff;
- 26 3. Plaintiff shall be responsible for filing all documents in paper form, until such time
- 27 as he signs and returns the Clerk's "Petition by Pro Se Litigant" form and is issued
