20	The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C.	
21	§ 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. On December 1, 2016, the assigned magistrate judge issued	
22	findings and recommendations recommending plaintiff's motions for access to photocopy	
23	services be denied. The findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained	
24	notice that objections thereto were to be filed within thirty days. The thirty day time frame has	
25	expired and no objections were filed.	
26	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the undersigned has	
27	conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the
