PARTIES WISH SETTLEMENT
CONFERENCE
DEADLINE: NOVEMBER 1, 2024

On October 22, 2024, the Parties participated in an informal discovery dispute hearing. (Doc. No. 172). During the hearing the Court offered the parties an opportunity to engage in a final settlement conference before the undersigned.¹ The Parties agreed to discuss whether a settlement conference would be fruitful but wish to preserve the current pre-trial and trial dates.

Accordingly, it is ORDERED:

No later than November 1, 2024 the Parties shall provide notice if they wish to engage in a settlement conference.
