On October 4, 2017, he filed two motions in this case. 20 The first of these states that Petitioner has moved to a different institution and he 21 requests that the Court substitute the new warden as Respondent. This request will be 22 granted. Pursuant to Rule 25(d) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Warden Dean 23 Borders is hereby substituted as the proper Respondent in this action. 24 The second motion requests a copy of Petitioner's first amended petition and any 25 report, recommendation, or denial thereon. However, no amended petition has been 26 filed. Additionally, the original petition has not been addressed on the merits and no 27 report, recommendation, or denial exists.

The matter now is fully briefed and ready for disposition. Petitioner does not explain why he requires copies of court documents at the present time. The request will be denied without prejudice. For the foregoing reasons, it is HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The motion to change respondent (ECF No. 18) is GRANTED; and 2. The motion for copies (ECF No. 19) is DENIED. IT IS SO ORDERED. 1st Michael J.
