22	completed application to proceed in	forma pauperis. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914, 1915. Based on	
23	Plaintiff's failure to comply with the Court's order, dismissal of this action is appropriate. <i>In re</i>		
24 25	Phenylpropanolamine (PPA) Products Liability Litigation, 460 F.3d 1217, 1226 (9th Cir. 2006);		
25 26	Local Rule 110. Accordingly, it is HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice for Plaintiff's failure to comply with the Court's order and to pay the filing fee or file a
