24 The parties have agreed that this action will not proceed on Count IV (Violation of California  
25 Business and Professions Code Section 17200, et seq.) of plaintiff's complaint and have agreed further  
26 that each party will bear its/her own fees costs related to this Count. (Doc. 47) The stipulation relies  
27 upon Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1) which makes it effective upon its signing without  
28 further order of the Court. Wilson v. City of San Jose, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Thus, the  
Court **ORDERS**, the stipulation is **GRANTED**. The action will not proceed upon Count IV  
according to the stipulation of the parties.
