See Doc. No. 24. The Court also provided a 19 briefing schedule for parties to follow if they could not reach agreement on the issue of attorneys' 20 fees and costs. See id. After extensions of time were granted, on April 28, 2017, Plaintiff's 21 counsel submitted a notice of settlement with respect to the issue of attorneys' fees and costs. See 22 Doc. No. 34. Because it appears that an agreement has been reached on the issue of attorneys' 23 fees and costs, the latest briefing schedule is now moot. 24 25 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 26 The briefing schedule set on March 31, 2017 is VACATED in light of the notice of 1. 27 settlement; 28

1	2. Within fourteen days of service of this order, the parties shall submit any further
2	appropriate documents to the Court that may be necessary to effectuate full settlement of
3	Plaintiff Patricia Mugrauer's claims; and
4	3. This case remains open and on-going with respect to the claims by Plaintiff Wade
5	Mugrauer.
