ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS TO:

- (1) DENY PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND/OR PROTECTIVE ORDER;**
- (2) DENY PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR A COURT ORDER EMERGENCY CIRCUMSTANCES TELEPHONIC CONFERENCE;**
- (3) DENY PLAINTIFF’S MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER; AND**
- (4) DENY PLAINTIFF’S REQUEST FOR A PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND A TEMPORARAY RESTRAINING ORDER**

(ECF NOS. 24, 32, 35, 38, 51.)

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On November 7, 2017, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which were served on Plaintiff and which contained notice to Plaintiff that any

1 objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days.
2 (ECF No. 51.) Plaintiff has not filed objections to the findings and recommendations.

3 The Court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be
4 supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS
5 HEREBY ORDERED that:

6 1. The findings and recommendations filed November 7, 2017 (ECF No. 51), are
7 ADOPTED IN FULL; and

8 2. Plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction and/or protective order (ECF No. 24)
9 is DENIED;

10 3. Plaintiff's motion for a "court order emergency circumstance[s] telephonic
11 conference" (ECF No. 32) is DENIED;

12 4. Plaintiff's motion for temporary restraining order (ECF No. 35) is DENIED; and

13 5. Plaintiff's request for a preliminary injunction and a temporary restraining order
14 (ECF No. 38) is DENIED.

15 IT IS SO ORDERED.
