

1 Plaintiff has not shown good cause for the court to grant him another extension of time to
2 file the amended complaint. It has been more than seven months since the court issued its order
3 requiring Plaintiff to file the amended complaint. The court's order gave Plaintiff ample
4 guidance, explaining at length why Plaintiff's complaint was deficient and how to cure the
5 deficiencies. Plaintiff does not need to conduct extensive research at the law library to prepare
6 the amended complaint. Plaintiff was given the applicable law in the court's order. As instructed
7 by the order, Plaintiff needs to file an amended complaint alleging the facts of his case in detail,
8 explaining what happened and what he knows.

9 Therefore, Plaintiff's motion for extension of time shall be denied, without prejudice to
10 renewal of the motion within twenty days. Plaintiff shall be granted twenty days in which to file
11 a new motion for extension of time, showing good cause. No further extensions shall be granted
12 without a showing of good cause.

13 Accordingly, based on the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 14 1. Plaintiff's motions for extension of time, filed on January 12, 2017, and February
15 10, 2017, are DENIED, without prejudice;
- 16 2. Plaintiff is granted twenty days from the date of service in which to file a new
17 motion for extension of time, showing good cause; and
- 18 3. Plaintiff's failure to comply with this order may result in dismissal of this case
19 without further notice.

20 IT IS SO ORDERED.
