On May 12, 2016, Plaintiff Janie Montoya Castaneda filed a complaint. (ECF No. 1.) On that same date, Plaintiff filed a motion to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u> pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915. (ECF No. 2.) On May 17, 2016, the Court issued an order requiring Plaintiff to complete and file an Application to Proceed in District Court Without Prepaying Fees or Costs (Long Form) – AO 239. (ECF No. 3.) The Court was unable to determine at that time whether Plaintiff met the requirements of 28 U.S.C. § 1915, because Plaintiff's first <u>in forma pauperis</u> application was not adequately completed. On June 6, 2016, Plaintiff filed an amended motion to proceed <u>in forma pauperis</u>. (ECF No. 4.) Plaintiff's application demonstrates entitlement to proceed without prepayment of fees.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis is GRANTED;
