



1 182(f), 183(b). Additionally, Local Rule 110 provides that “[f]ailure . . . of a party to comply with  
2 these [Local] Rules or with any order of the Court may be grounds for imposition by the Court of any  
3 and all sanctions . . . within the inherent power of the Court.” Further, the failure of Plaintiff to  
4 prosecute this action is grounds for dismissal. In re Phenylpropanolamine (PPA) Products Liability  
5 Litigation, 460 F.3d 1217 (9th Cir. 2006).

6 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that, within fourteen (14) days from the date of  
7 service of this order, Plaintiff shall show cause in writing why this action should not be dismissed for  
8 failure to prosecute and failure to obey a court order. **The failure to respond to this order will result**  
9 **in dismissal of this action.**
