Plaintiff Armando Abreu (“Plaintiff”), a state prisoner proceeding pro se and inform a pauperis, filed this action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, on May 23, 2016. On June 7, 2017, the Court screened Plaintiff’s second amended complaint and granted Plaintiff leave to file a third amended complaint. (ECF No. 19.)
