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16 Darlene Garcia and FCA US LLC stipulated to dismiss the action with prejudice pursuant to  
17 Fed.R.Civ.P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), under which “the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by  
18 filing . . . a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.” (*See* Doc. 92) Because  
19 all parties have signed the stipulation, it “automatically terminate[d] the action.” *Wilson v. City of San*  
20 *Jose*, 111 F.3d 688, 692 (9th Cir. 1997). Accordingly, based upon the stipulation of the parties, the  
21 Clerk of Court is **DIRECTED** to close this action.
