The Court also ordered Plaintiff's counsel 21 to serve the March 29, 2017 order on Plaintiff and file a proof of service. 22 On April 3, 2017, Plaintiff filed his opening brief. Plaintiff's counsel has not yet filed the 23 proof of service of the March 29, 2017 order. Therefore, the Court issues the following order 24 amending the scheduling order. However, the Court shall not address the late opening brief until 25 the March 29, 2017 order is fully complied with. 26 /// 27
