Plaintiff Javier Martinez and Defendant Carolyn Colvin, Acting Commissioner of Social Security, stipulated to dismiss the action with prejudice pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), under which “the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing . . . a stipulation of dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared.” (*See* Doc. 10)
