17	Plaintiff Shannon Williams, a prisoner in the custody of the Federal Bureau of Prisons		
18	("BOP") proceeding pro se filed the instant civil rights action pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown		
19	Federal Narcotics Agents, 403 U.S. 388 (1971) on June 2, 2016.		
20	On September 29, 2016, the Court screened Plaintiff's complaint and directed that Plaintiff		
21	either file an amended complaint or notify the Court of intent to proceed only on the claim found to be		
22	cognizable.		
23	Plaintiff filed a first amended complaint on November 9, 2016.		
24	On February 27, 2017, Plaintiff filed a motion requesting the status of the case. As Plaintiff		
25	was advised in the First Informational Order, "[t]his Court screens pro se plaintiff's complaints as		
26	expeditiously as possible. However, the Court has an extremely large number of pro se plaintiff civil		
27	rights cases pending before it, and delay is inevitable. As long as a party keeps the Court informed of

1	the party's current address, the Court will provide notice of all actions which might affect the case as		
2	soon as an action is taken in the case." (ECF No. 2, Order at III (C).) The Court is aware of Plaintiff's		
3	action and will screen the complaint in due course. Plaintiff is advised that the Court will not file or		
4	respond in writing to any future requests for status of the case.
