15	On June 7, 2016, the Court denied Plaintiff Jennifer Phou's application to proceed <i>in forma</i>	
16	<i>pauperis.</i> Doc. 3. Because the application was incomplete, the Court could not evaluate whether	
17	Plaintiff was sufficiently impoverished to justify proceeding without paying the filing fee for his	
18	lawsuit. Plaintiff was ordered to pay the filing fee or re-file a completed application within thirty	
19 20	(30) days of the order. Nearly two weeks after the 30-day deadline, Plaintiff submitted an amended	
20		
21	application on July 18, 2016. Accompanying the amended application is a declaration from her	
22	counsel, Jacqueline A. Forslund. Therein, Ms. Forslund explained why the amended application was	
23	not timely filed. Satisfied with Ms. Forslund's explanation, the Court therefore accepts the late	
24	amended application to proceed <i>in forma pauperis</i> . ¹
