On October 25, 2017, Defendant filed an amended motion for summary judgment. (ECF No. 22.) The filing of the amended motion for summary judgment renders Defendant's ex parte motion to seal exhibits moot. Therefore, the

court shall deny the motion to seal exhibits as moot. If Defendant seeks to seal exhibits

supporting the amended motion for summary judgment, Defendant must file a new motion to seal exhibits based on the amended motion for summary judgment.
