

1 Plaintiff now requests a 90 to 120-day stay of this action pending the outcome of the criminal
2 case, and for other counsel “to get up to speed if the case proceeds” and Plaintiff’s counsel
3 becomes “more incapacitated.” (Doc. 10 at p. 3).

4 Having considered counsels’ response, it is **HEREBY ORDERED** as follows:

- 5 1. The Court’s Order to Show Cause issued on October 10, 2016, is **HEREBY**
6 **DISCHARGED** and no sanctions will be imposed;
- 7 2. Plaintiff’s request for a stay is **GRANTED**;
- 8 3. This action is **STAYED** for 120 days during the pendency of Plaintiff’s criminal
9 action; and
- 10 4. No later than **February 1, 2017**, Plaintiff shall file a written status report detailing the
11 status of this action and the related criminal matter.

12 **IT IS SO ORDERED.**
