2 accommodate a Zoom video appearance by Plaintiff at this date and time, and providing the  
3 necessary Zoom contact information. If the institution is unable to accommodate a video  
4 appearance, counsel may arrange for Plaintiff's appearance by telephone, using the same Zoom  
5 contact information.
