2. The custodian is ordered to notify the Court of any change in custody of this inmate and is ordered to provide the new custodian with a copy of this writ.
3. The Clerk of Court is directed to serve a copy of this order via fax on the Litigation Office at Mule Creek State Prison at (209) 274-5018 or via email.
4. If prison officials have any questions concerning the telephonic connection or difficulty connecting, they shall contact Alexandra Waldrop, Courtroom Deputy, at (916) 930-4187.
