Plaintiff Michael Carter is appearing pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The Court has determined that this case will benefit from a settlement conference. Therefore, this case will be referred to Magistrate Judge Michael J. Seng to conduct a settlement conference at the California State Prison, Corcoran (CSP-COR), 4001 King Avenue, Corcoran, CA 93212 on June 9, 2017, at 8:30 a.m. The Court will issue the necessary transportation order by separate order.

In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. This case is set for a settlement conference before Magistrate Judge Michael J. Seng on June 9, 2017, at CSP-COR.
2. A representative with full and unlimited authority to negotiate and enter into a binding settlement shall attend in person.
3. Those in attendance must be prepared to discuss the claims, defenses and damages. The

1 failure of any counsel, party or authorized person subject to this order to appear in person
2 may result in the imposition of sanctions. In addition, the conference will not proceed and
3 will be reset to another date.

4 4. The parties shall bring a confidential settlement statement to the settlement conference on
5 June 9, 2017. Settlement statements **should not be filed** with the Clerk of the Court **nor**
6 **served on any other party.**

7 5. The confidential settlement statement shall be **no longer than five pages** in length, typed
8 or neatly printed, and include the following:

- 9 a. A brief statement of the facts of the case.
- 10 b. A brief statement of the claims and defenses, i.e., statutory or other grounds upon
11 which the claims are founded; a forthright evaluation of the parties' likelihood of
12 prevailing on the claims and defenses; and a description of the major issues in
13 dispute.
- 14 c. An estimate of the cost and time to be expended for further discovery, pretrial, and
15 trial.
- 16 d. The party's position on settlement, including present demands and offers and a
17 history of past settlement discussions, offers, and demands.
- 18 e. A brief statement of each party's expectations and goals for the settlement
19 conference, including how much a party is willing to accept and/or willing to pay.
