**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT
ZAMORA’S REQUEST BY SPECIAL
APPEARANCE FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
(ECF No. 103.)**

THIRTY-DAY DEADLINE

Jeremy Jones (“Plaintiff”) is a state prisoner proceeding *pro se* and *in forma pauperis* with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 and the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), 42 U.S.C. § 12132. This case now proceeds with Plaintiff’s Second Amended Complaint, filed on September 10, 2018, on (1) Plaintiff’s ADA claims against defendants Vasquez, Keener, Gonzales,¹ Flores, Arnett,² Zamora, and Lopez, in their official capacities; 2) Plaintiff’s Eighth Amendment conditions of confinement claims against defendants Vasquez, Keener, and Gonzales; and (3) Plaintiff’s due process claims against defendants Vasquez, Keener, and Gonzales. (ECF No. 33.)

² Sued as Arnette.

1 On August 6, 2021, the court issued an order to show cause, requiring defendant Zamora
2 to respond, showing cause why default should not be entered against Zamora. (ECF No. 99.) On
3 September 7, 2021, defendant Zamora, by special appearance, requested an extension of time to
4 respond to the order to show cause. (ECF No. 103.)

5 The Court finds good cause to grant defendant Zamora an extension of time.
6 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendant Zamora is granted an extension of time
7 until thirty days from the date of this order in which to file a response to the court's order to show
8 cause issued on August 6, 2021.
