14 On December 17, 2015, Plaintiff Sandy Poindexter filed the complaint in this matter
15 Fresno County Superior Court against Defendants J.C. Penney Corporation and Does 1 to 100.
16 Doc. 1. The complaint was served on Defendant J.C. Penney on August 5, 2016. *Id.* The action
17 was removed to this Court on August 30, 2016. *Id.* An answer was filed on September 6, 2016.
18 Doc. 6. On May 31, 2018, the parties filed a stipulated dismissal of this action with prejudice
19 pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). The parties request that this court
20 retain jurisdiction to enforce the settlement agreement. According to Federal Rule of Civil
21 Procedure 41(a)(1)(B), the parties' stipulation operates as a dismissal with prejudice.

22 Based on the parties' stipulation, this action is dismissed with prejudice. The Court retains
23 jurisdiction to enforce the settlement. The Clerk of the Court is respectfully directed to close this
24 case.
