

1 objections, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and
2 by proper analysis.

3 In his objections, plaintiff appears to misapprehend the scope of the recommendation set
4 forth in the findings and recommendations and, therefore, generally restates the allegations of his
5 complaint and contends that he has stated a claim for relief. Contrary to plaintiff's statement, the
6 assigned magistrate judge has not recommended dismissal of all of plaintiff's claims. (*See* Doc.
7 No. 26 at 1.) Accordingly, plaintiff's objections do not call the findings and recommendations
8 into question, and the court will adopt them in full.

9 Accordingly,

- 10 1. The findings and recommendations issued on May 23, 2018 (Doc. No. 25) are
11 adopted in full;
- 12 2. This action shall proceed on the claim in plaintiff's second amended complaint
13 (Doc. No. 21) against defendants R. Speidell and M. Stewart for retaliation in
14 violation of the First Amendment;
- 15 3. All other claims and defendants are dismissed; and
- 16 4. The matter is referred back to the assigned magistrate judge for further
17 proceedings consistent with this order.
