



1 The Court has reviewed Plaintiff's complaint and his allegations do not satisfy the imminent  
2 danger exception to section 1915(g). Andrews v. Cervantes, 493 F.3d 1047, 1055-56 (9th Cir. 2007).  
3 Plaintiff asserts that from sometime in December 2013 until February 8, 2015, Faith Perez, a  
4 psychiatric technician at Coalinga State Hospital, sexually abused him, and his claims arise out of the  
5 alleged abuse. He further alleges that he is an ex-patient of that hospital, having left that institution on  
6 February 9, 2016 (Doc. 1, pp. 3 and 8), and who is currently being held at the Fresno Men's County  
7 Jail, (id. at 1). Plaintiff makes no allegations concerning any imminent danger of serious physical  
8 injury. Therefore, Plaintiff has not satisfied the exception from the three strikes bar under 28 U.S.C. §  
9 1915(g), and must pay the \$400.00 filing fee if he wishes to litigate this claim.

10 Accordingly, the Court HEREBY ORDERS as follows:

- 11 1. Plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis (Doc. 2) is DENIED; and,
- 12 2. This action is DISMISSED without prejudice to re-filing accompanied by the \$400.00  
13 filing fee.
