**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S

14 Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in this civil rights action pursuant to
15 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Defendant removed this action from state court and now requests
16 that the Court screen Plaintiff's complaint in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915A. That
17 request is HEREBY GRANTED. The Court will screen Plaintiff's complaint in due
18 course.

19 Defendant also asks that they not be required to answer or otherwise defend
20 against this action until thirty days after the screening order is entered. Defendant's
21 request is HEREBY GRANTED. Defendants shall answer or otherwise respond to
22 Plaintiff's claims within thirty days of the Court's screening order if any claims are found
23 to be cognizable.
