Fields ("Plaintiff") is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in 14 forma pauperis in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On July 23, 2018, defense 15 16 counsel filed a stipulation for voluntary dismissal with prejudice pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). (ECF No. 28.) The stipulation is signed by Plaintiff and counsel for 17 Defendant Ruiz, indicating that the case has been resolved in its entirety, should be dismissed 18 19 with prejudice, and each side shall bear their own litigation costs and attorney's fees. 20 Accordingly, in light of the parties' voluntary dismissal, this action is terminated by operation of law without further order from the Court.
