12	Plaintiff is a civil detainee proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this civil		
13	rights action brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On February 27, 2017, Plaintiff's first		
14	amended complaint was dismissed without leave to amend, and the matter was closed.		
15	(ECF Nos. 13, 14.)		
16	Before the Court is Plaintiff's April 19, 2017 Motion to Vacate Judgment, brought		
17	pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 59(e). This is Plaintiff's second such motion.		
18	(See ECF No. 15.) It is nearly identical to the first. Once again, Plaintiff provides no basis		
19	for vacating the Court's judgment, reconsidering its prior ruling, or providing Plaintiff		
20	relief. The cases cited by Plaintiff are inapposite.		
21	Accordingly, the motion to vacate judgment (ECF No. 22) is HEREBY DENIED.
