20	the Court will extend the discovery deadline as they request, counsel are advised that the Court <u>will</u>	
21	<u>not</u> extend this deadline again regardless of whether the case resolves at the mediation or whether	
22	it proceeds in the timeframe currently anticipated. Thus, the Court ORDERS:	
23	1. The stipulation to extend the non-expert discovery deadline to May 3, 2019 is	
24	GRANTED. <u>No other deadlines are amended</u> .
