19	1. Defendants' ex parte request for an extension of time is GRANTED IN PART;	
20	2. Defendants shall file a response to Plaintiff's motion to dismiss no later than 2:00 p.m. on	
21	January 20, 2017;	
22	3. Plaintiff shall file a reply to any response by Defendants no later than 2:00 p.m. on January	
23	27, 2017.
