**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE RE ADDRESS  
CHANGE**

13 Plaintiff Juan Matias Torres, a state prisoner, is proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis in this  
14 civil rights action brought under 28 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff's Complaint, ECF No. 1, is currently  
15 before the Court for screening.

16 A pro se plaintiff must keep the Court informed of his correct current address. Local Rule  
17 182(f). If a party moves to a different address without filing and serving a notice of change of address,  
18 documents served at a party's old address of record shall be deemed received even if not actually  
19 received. *Id.* Local Rule 183(b) requires a party proceeding pro se to keep the Court apprised of his  
20 current address: "If mail directed to a plaintiff in propria persona by the Clerk is returned by the U.S.  
21 Postal service, and if such plaintiff fails to notify the Court and opposing parties within sixty-three (63)  
22 days thereafter of a current address, the Court may dismiss the action without prejudice for failure to  
23 prosecute."

24 Plaintiff's Complaint indicates that he was housed at California State Prison, Solano ("CSP-  
25 Solano"), in Vacaville, California, when he filed the Complaint, which the Court received on October

1 11, 2016. Complaint at 1. On October 12, 2016, Magistrate Judge Michael Seng issued an order  
2 informing Plaintiff of Local Rules 182(f) and 183(b), and providing Plaintiff with a change of address  
3 form. ECF No. 4. Plaintiff's subsequent notice declining to proceed before Judge Seng, which he filed  
4 on October 21, 2016, within the provided deadline, indicates that he received and understood Judge  
5 Seng's order. ECF No. 7.

6 According to the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation's public records, as  
7 of the date of this Order, Plaintiff is now housed at North Kern State Prison in Delano, California. The  
8 Court is not aware of the date that Plaintiff moved from CSP-Solano to North Kern Stat Prison, but in  
9 the interest of ensuring Plaintiff's compliance with Local Rules 182(f) and 183(b), now ORDERS  
10 Plaintiff to notify the Court of his current address within **thirty (30) days of the date of this Order.**  
11 Failure to respond to this Order will result in the Court dismissing this case for failure to prosecute.
