21	The parties seek remand for an administrative law judge to conduct "further proceedings,	
22	including a new hearing and a new decision." (Doc. 19 at 1) In addition, the parties stipulated for the	
23	matter to be remanded under sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g), and request final judgment be	
24	entered in favor of Plaintiff. (Id. at 1-12)	
25	Based upon the stipulation of the parties, the Court <b>ORDERS</b> :	
26	1. The matter is <b>REMANDED</b> un	nder four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g); and

28		hissioner of Social Security. Pursuant to Rule 25(d) of the Federal A. Berryhill for her predecessor, Carolyn W. Colvin, as the defendant.
