19	action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge	
20	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
21	On December 29, 2016, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and	
22	recommendations recommending that plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis be denied	
23	under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g) and that plaintiff be required to pay the \$400.00 filing fee in full to	
24	proceed with this action. (Doc. No. 9.) The findings and recommendations were served on	
25	plaintiff and contained notice that objections thereto were to be filed within thirty days. Over	
26	thirty days have passed, and no objections have been filed.	
27	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), the undersigned has	
28	conducted a <i>de novo</i> review of this case. Have	ving carefully reviewed the entire file, the
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1	undersigned concludes the findings and recommendations are supported by the record and by	
2	proper analysis.	
3	Accordingly:	
4	1. The findings and recommendations filed on December 29, 2016 (Doc. No. 9) are	
5	adopted in full;	
6	2. Plaintiff's applications to proceed in forma pauperis (Doc. No. 8) is denied; and	
7	3. Plaintiff shall pay the required \$400.00 filing fee in full within thirty (30) days of this	
8	order. Failure to comply with this order will result in dismissal of this case.
