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1 **STIPULATION**

17 opt-in plaintiffs no later than February 6, 2018. Any individuals seeking to opt-in to the action
18 must complete and file the consent form no later than April 22, 2018.

19 The parties’ Mid-Discovery Status Conference shall be continued from March 26, 2018
20 at 8:30 a.m. to April 23, 2018 at 8:30 a.m. or to a later date the Court deems appropriate and
21 convenient.
