plaintiffs ndant the United States. (Doc. 70.) Good cause appearing, the request is GRANTED.

On January 28, 2021, the parties participated in a mediation with a private mediator. Although the case did not settle at the mediation, the parties have remained engaged in good faith settlement discussions with the assistance of the mediator since that time and continue to negotiate in good faith. The parties advise the Court that they believe the most productive way forward is to continue to focus on settlement discussions rather than conducting discovery. A stay of the discovery schedule is necessary to avoid any question about whether the parties should also have been conducting discovery simultaneously with their settlement efforts. Neither party will be prejudiced by the requested stay, which is of a modest duration. If the case does not settle, the parties can resume discovery after the stay expires.
