On January 4, 2017, Plaintiff's complaint was dismissed with leave to 20 amend for failure to satisfy Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 8(a). (ECF No. 11.) 21 On January 13, 2017, Plaintiff filed a motion for extension of time to file an 22 amended complaint, and this request was granted on January 23, 2017. (ECF Nos. 12, 23 13.) Now pending are two more motions for extension of time to file an amended 24 complaint. (ECF Nos. 14, 15.) 25 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 26 1. Plaintiff is granted 30 days from the date of service of this order in which to file 27 an amended complaint; 28 1

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2. The Clerk of Court is directed to send Plaintiff a blank civil rights complaint form and a copy of the Court's February 4, 2017, Screening Order. Plaintiff is advised to abide by the criteria set forth in the Screening Order, including the 20-page limit and no attachments.
