(ECF No. 37). On July 5, 2018, Plaintiff submitted one copy 21 of the Second Amended Complaint to the Court (ECF No. 41), and asked that five copies be made 22 without prepayment of costs because he cannot afford the copying costs (it is not clear whether 23 Plaintiff wants the Court or his institution of confinement to make the copies). 24 Plaintiff is not entitled to free copies from the Court. Moreover, Plaintiff's motion is 25

silent as to whether his institution of confinement will allow him to make the legally required

copies without prepayment of costs. If Plaintiff can make copies through his institution's

procedures, there is no need for Court involvement. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that: 1. Plaintiff's motion for copies is DENIED, without prejudice to Plaintiff filing another motion for copies after he attempts to make copies through his institution. If Plaintiff does file another motion, he should attach his institution's response to his request for copies; and 2. Plaintiff has thirty days from the date of service of this order to submit five copies of his Second Amended Complaint to the Court or to file another motion for copies in compliance with the instructions above.
