ORDER DIRECTING SERVICE OF
SUBPOENA BY THE UNITED STATES
MARSHALS SERVICE WITHOUT
PREPAYMENT OF COSTS

18 The Court previously granted Plaintiff's motion for the issuance of a subpoena upon
19 Mercy Hospital by the United States Marshals Service. (ECF No. 82). Plaintiff has now
20 completed and returned the subpoena and form USM-285.¹

21 Accordingly, it is HEREBY ORDERED that:

22 1. The Clerk of the Court shall forward the following documents to the United States
23 Marshals Service:

24 a. One (1) completed and issued subpoena *duces tecum*;

25 b. One (1) completed USM-285 form; and
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28 ¹ Plaintiff actually completed and returned two identical subpoenas and two identical form USM-285s. As the subpoenas are identical, and as the Court only authorized one subpoena, the Court will only direct the United States Marshals Service to serve one subpoena.

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- c. Two (2) copies of this order, one to accompany the subpoena and one for the United States Marshals Service.
- 2. The Clerk of Court is directed to attach a copy of the completed subpoena *duces tecum* to this order.
- 3. Within TWENTY (20) DAYS from the date of this order, the United States Marshals Service SHALL effect personal service of the subpoena, along with a copy of this order, upon the entity named in the subpoena pursuant to Rule 45 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and 28 U.S.C. § 566(c).
- 4. The United States Marshals Service is DIRECTED to retain a copy of the subpoena in its file for future use.
- 5. Within TEN (10) DAYS after personal service is effected, the United States Marshals Service SHALL file the return of service.
