# Case No. 1:16-cv-01689-NONE-JLT (PC) <br> ORDER GRANTING PLAINTIFF'S SECOND MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE OPPOSITION 

(Doc. 59)
30-DAY DEADLINE

On February 7, 2020, Defendant filed a motion for summary judgment on the grounds that Plaintiff failed to exhaust administrative remedies prior to filing suit. (Doc. 55.) Plaintiff requests a second, 30-day extension of time to file an opposition to Defendant's motion. (Doc. 59.) Plaintiff states that she requires the additional time due the coronavirus pandemic, which has "cause[d] [her] to have ... very limited access to the prison law library" and is hindering her ability to "complete [her] anticipated opposition." (Id.) Good cause appearing, the Court GRANTS Plaintiff $\mathbf{3 0}$ days from the date of service of this order to file an opposition or statement of non-opposition to Defendant's motion for summary judgment.
