14	1983. On May 16, 2019, Plaintiff filed a motion to extend time to file objections to findings and	
15	recommendations. Good cause having been presented to the court, this motion will be granted.	
16	However, on May 16, 2019, Plaintiff also filed a motion to initiate discovery. Discovery has not	
17	yet opened and this case is currently set for a court supervised settlement conference on June 6,	
18	2019. If the settlement conference is not successful, a Discovery and Scheduling Order will issue	
19	which will open discovery.	
20	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff is GRANTED 30 days from the	
21	date of service of this order in which to file objections to findings and recommendations, but	
22	Plaintiff's motion to initiate discovery is DENIED without prejudice.
