ORDER RE STIPULATION FOR
SEVEN-DAY EXTENSION OF NON-
EXPERT DISCOVERY DEADLINE
(ECF No. 13)

The parties to this action hereby stipulate, and request that the Court order, that the deadline for completion of non-expert discovery be extended by seven (7) days, to August 25, 2017, on the following grounds:

1. On July 10, 2017, the United States noticed the deposition of plaintiff Kathy Martin, with production of documents, for August 17, 2017, at 10 a.m. On August 7, 2017, plaintiffs noticed the depositions of two United States Postal Service employees for the following day, August 18, 2017.

2. Ms. Martin failed to appear for her deposition at the scheduled time on August 17, 2017, and Ms. Martin's counsel was unable to reach her by telephone until late in the afternoon. Counsel for the parties agreed that the United States should be allowed to complete the earlier-noticed deposition of Ms. Martin before producing the postal employees. The deposition of Ms. Martin was rescheduled for the following day, August 18, 2017, at 10 a.m.
